Description

Auditory learners pick up on things they hear. It may be music, a conversation, or even a lecture.

Ideas for Adults

- Listen to an audio Bible. They come in all types and translations. You can even get dramatized versions. You can listen to the Bible for family worship or for your own personal time with God. - If you are using Bible study guides that have questions, read and answer the questions out loud.
- Read out loud as much as possible. You can even record yourself and play it back. This will be one of your most helpful tools for Bible study.
- Share with others. As you hear yourself share, and hear comments of others, the truths you've been learning will stick with you more.
- Music is important. Learning or writing [scripture songs](#) will help you remember passages. Songs can also be helpful to remember [Bible stories](#) and facts like the [12 disciples](#) or the [books of the Bible](#).

Ideas for Kids

- Provide an audio Bible for your child. These are available in various versions and at various prices. Encourage your child to follow along in his own Bible as he listens. You can find audio Bibles in our [online store](#) or at [Faith Comes By Hearing](#).
- Ask or record questions for your child. Depending on your child's personality, you may want to ask her questions in person or you may record Bible study questions for her ahead of time. Make sure you give her time to answer out loud.
- Read to your child from the Bible. Encourage him to read to you as well.
- Ask your child lots of questions about what she's reading and make time to discuss. What has she been studying? What is she learning? How can she apply that to her own life? What can she learn about God?
- Give your auditory learner lots of opportunities to share. The more he shares, the better he will grasp important truths.
- Provide [scripture songs](#) and [Bible focused music](#). Music is a key component of learning for an auditory learner. You can even encourage your child to write her own music or put verses to tunes she already knows.
